Qatar e-Nature Schools Contest 2020 **Terms and Conditions**

Please read these terms and conditions carefully. If you enter the Qatar e-Nature Schools Contest (the "Competition") we will assume you have read these terms and conditions and agree to be bound by them.

- The Contest is conducted by Sasol, Friends of the Environment Centre in Qatar and • Ministry of Education & Higher Education (the Organisers).
- The Contest is open to all the students (governmental and private) in Qatar from • Grade/Year 1 to Grade/Year 12.
- One entry is permitted per eligible student.
- These terms and conditions will be interpreted by the Organisers and the Organisers' decision regarding any dispute will be final and binding.
- The Organizers reserve the right to withdraw or suspend the Competition or alter the • deadline for participation at any time and are under no obligation to give reasons for doing so.
- Nothing in these terms and conditions or any other information relating to the Competition will obligate the Organisers to award a prize to any entrant.
- Prizes are not transferable or exchangeable for cash or any other prize. •
- If a prize is not available, we reserve the right to offer an alternative prize of equal or greater value.
- Employees of Sasol, Friends of the Environment and their immediate families as well as persons otherwise connected with the competition/prize draw and their immediate families are not eligible to enter the Competition.
- All participants must provide full contact details: name, age, email address (or that of parent), school name, and grade/year to join the competition. Phone number is optional. This information will only be used for the purposes of the Competition and any purposes ancillary to the Competition.
- Participants are required to select the correct answer from the options presented for each question. Correct answers can be found within the Qatar e-Nature application. Incorrectly completed entries will be disqualified.
- Proof of submission of an entry is not proof of receipt of an entry. No responsibility can be accepted for entries which are lost or delayed or not received for any other reason.
- Deadline for participation: 11:59 PM on March 31, 2020 •
- Winners will be determined through a draw and awarded valuable prizes. •
- Entries with all the questions correctly answered will automatically qualify for the draw for the Draw Prizes.
- A draw will take place from among the qualified entries during Mars 2020 to determine the winners of the Draw Prizes. This will be done under the auspices of an independent auditor. The Draw Prizes are restricted to one prize per school grade.
- The list of winners will be announced through a notification on the application's home screen and on Qatar e-Nature app's and website (enature.ga).
- The Organisers will attempt to contact the winners by email and/or phone to attend the prize award ceremony. Should Sasol not be able to contact a certain winner that person shall be disqualified and another entry will be chosen within 3 working days from the time of the winners' announcement.
- If the winner of the Prize or his/her legal guardian declines the Prize, another raffle draw will be conducted to choose another winner.
- On acceptance of any prize, winners consent to the use of their names and photographs by the Organisers for advertising and marketing purposes.
- The Judging Panel's and/or Organisers' decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
